## Did You Know...

## Parking Regulations

- > No parking on any city street after a plowable snowfall of 2" or more until streets are cleared.
- No vehicle shall be parked upon any street in any one place for a longer continuous period than 48 hours

## <u>Sidewalks</u>

Sidewalks should be shoveled within 24 hours after snowfall.

#### **Dog Licenses**

<u>ALL dogs must be licensed</u>. Licenses can be obtained at the City Hall. Only three dogs per residence are allowed. Bring a copy of the Rabies Vaccination.

#### **Building Permits**

Building permits are required for all outside improvements (except painting). <u>All permits must be approved</u> <u>before construction begins</u>. Please apply for a permit at least 2 weeks before project is to begin.

Lembke Building-103 Main Street N., you can register for voting by calling Faribault County Auditor's Office at 507-526-6213 or you can register the day of elections in Minnesota Lake.

#### **REMEMBER TO: Call before you Dig**

It's the law to call before digging. Call Gopher State One - 811.

#### **RECYCLING/GARBAGE**

Recycling is every <u>1st and 3rd Tuesday</u> of every month. Have your recycling out early in the morning! See attached information sheets. The brown carts with yellow lids are for recycling ONLY – **no garbage**!

Garbage is picked up every Thursday; please have your bins out by 8:00 a.m. You do not need to put out your bin every week if your bin is not full. Extra garbage bags (yellow) are sold at City Hall on Main Street- Cost-\$26.00/pkg (10 bags). If yellow bags are set out they <u>must be tied and have</u> <u>a weight limit of 30#!</u>
